## **Directions to the Venue**

### **From the North:**

Take the A12 to Junction 19 and take the A130 exit to A138 Stanstead Airport/Sudbury/Chelmsford

At the roundabout take the 4<sup>th</sup> exit onto the Main Road/A130

At the next roundabout take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit onto A130

At next roundabout take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit onto Colchester Road/A130

Chelmsford Service Area

At next roundabout take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto White Hart Lane/A130

At next roundabout take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit and stay on White Hart Lane/A130

At next roundabout take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit and stay on White Hart Lane/A130

At next roundabout take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto Essex Regiment Way/A130

Turn left into Little Waltham Road

Destination will be on the left.

### **From the West:**

Take the A120 and take the exit B184 towards Great Dunmow

At roundabout take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto Chelmsford Road B1008

Follow B1008

At the roundabout take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit onto Essex Regiment Way/B1008

At next roundabout take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit on to Essex Regiment Way A130

Stay on Essex Regiment Way A130 at next 5 roundabouts (2<sup>nd</sup> exit 4 times & then 4<sup>th</sup> exit)

Turn Left on to Little Waltham Road and destination will be on the left.

### **From the South:**

M25 and on to A12 following signs for Chelmsford

Come off at Junction 19 and take the A130 for Stanstead Airport/Sudbury/Braintree/Chelmsford

At the roundabout take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit on to Colchester Road/A130
