Novice Test – not having won 1st 2nd or 3rd at an Open Test/any award at a Field Trial or 1st in a Novice or Intermediate Test
Veteran - For dogs not less than 7 years of age on the date of the test.

Entries will be accepted in respect of the same dog for both the novice and open tests. 1st and 2nd place prize winners of the Novice & Open tests will be asked to represent the club at the 2018 Golden Retriever Inter Club Working Test. However, please note that if you qualify for the Interclub Working Test in the morning and then win an award in the afternoon you immediately disqualify yourself from running in the Interclub working test as a novice dog.
